

# 2001 Reunion

Built in 1920, Lightship 103, Huron, is the last of the Great Lakes Lightships. At one time, there were 18 lightship stations on the Great Lakes. The lightship is owned by the City of Port Huron and is part of the Port Huron Museum.

**Ft Gratiot Lighthouse** is the oldest lighthouse in Michigan, built in 1829. We will be given a tour by USCG Aux. Bob Hanford, dressed in his 1800 uniform, and appropriate mustache. Bob will take you back to another time.
